BOB WOOLFORD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION FORM 2027-2028

The Bob Woolford Memorial Scholarship provides a deserving candidate with assistance needed to achieve future educational and career goals. This scholarship honors our friend and fellow Elks #794 member, Bob Woolford, who passed away in 2024 after a short illness. Always ready to be a friend and lend a hand when needed, Bob embodied the best characteristics of an Elk!

Supporting educational opportunities was very important to Bob. He left home prior to graduating from high school due to family issues and joined the Navy. After serving our country honorably, he earned his GED and continued his education at a Community College. He completed an AA degree while working and raising a family with his wife Jan. He later continued with classes at UCI. Bob believed that "sometimes life gives you circumstances; you just have to make the best of them and keep moving forward."

Eligible students must be planning to enroll or be currently enrolled in a two-year program at a Community College in Orange County for the Fall 2027 term. Funding for this scholarship is provided by donations from members, family, and friends of Santa Ana Elks #794.

Scholarship Award

For the 2027-2028 academic year, one scholarship of \$2,500 will be awarded. The winner will be eligible to reapply once for a second scholarship.

Qualification of Applicants

To qualify for the Bob Woolford Memorial Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following:

1. Be currently enrolled as a student at a community college or
2. Be currently enrolled in high school and plan to attend an accredited 2-year Community College in the upcoming school year
3. Be a resident of Orange County
4. Believe in God
5. Be an American citizen
6. Have a minimum of a 2.0 (C) grade point average
7. Be a person who participates in school, community, and employment opportunities
8. Complete the Bob Woolford Memorial Scholarship application in its entirety.
9. Provide/attach a copy of your transcript (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
10. Provide/attach letters of recommendation from 2 of the following: (1) a teacher, (2) a counselor, or (3) a community member

Scoring of Applications

The Santa Ana Elks Scholarship Committee will assess applications and select the winners. Winners will receive a “**Verification of Enrollment**” form to be completed **after** you have enrolled at the school you will be attending. Upon receiving the completed form and the required documentation of enrollment, a check will be sent as described on the verification form. If you elect to delay using the scholarship in the academic year for which it was awarded, a written request must be made to the Scholarship Chair.
