History of the McCalla Scholarship

The Robert McCalla Scholarship was established in November 2020 to honor Bob McCalla as he received his 70-year membership pin from the Santa Ana Elks #794. He served the Lodge on many levels and in many capacities, including Exalted Ruler and District Deputy Grand Exalter Ruler. He was the Building Committee Chairman and oversaw the construction of the new Santa Ana Elks Lodge which opened in June 2019. Education was always extremely important to Bob. It was his hope that this scholarship would provide a deserving candidate with the assistance needed to achieve future educational and career goals. Funding for this scholarship is provided by donations from family, friends and Santa Ana Elks #794 members.

Scholarship Award

For the 2027-2028 academic year, four scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded dependent on applicant qualifications. The winners will be eligible to have the scholarship renewed by reapplying.

Qualification of Applicants

To qualify for the McCalla Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following:

1. Be currently enrolled as a high school senior, college student, or be ready to enroll in a college of their choice;
2. Plan to attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year college, university, or vocational school in the upcoming school year;
3. Be a resident of Santa Ana, Tustin, or Irvine;
4. Believe in God;
5. Be an American citizen;
6. Be a person who participates in school, community, and employment opportunities;
7. Complete the McCalla Scholarship application in its entirety.
8. Provide/attach a copy of your transcript (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
9. Provide/attach letters of recommendation from each of the following: (1) a teacher, (2) a counselor, (3) a community member (total of 3 letters of recommendation)

Scoring of Applications

The Santa Ana Elks Scholarship Committee will assess applications and select the winners. Winners will receive a “**Verification of Enrollment**” form to be completed **after** you have enrolled at the school you will be attending. Upon receiving the completed form and the required documentation of enrollment, a check will be sent as described on the verification form. If you elect to delay using the scholarship in the academic year for which it was awarded, a written request must be made to the Scholarship Chair. The scholarship must be used within 18 months of its receipt.
