History of the Machado Family Community College Scholarship

This is the inaugural year for the Machado Family Community College Scholarship. The Santa Ana #794 Scholarship Committee wishes to provide a community college student with financial assistance to complete a transfer program to a four-year college or complete the necessary coursework to secure certification in their chosen career field. Eligible students must be planning to, or are currently enrolled in, a two-year program at the community college for the Fall 2026 term. Funding for this scholarship is provided by donations from the Machado family.

Scholarship Awards

For the 2026-2027 academic year, two scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded dependent on applicant qualifications.

Qualification of Applicants

To qualify for the Machado Family Community College Scholarship, applicants must meet all the following:

- Be currently enrolled as a community college student, or planning to enroll in an accredited two-year community college of their choice
- Possess a GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Be enrolled in a transfer program or a certificate program
- Be an Orange County resident
- Believe in God
- Be an American citizen
- Complete the Machado Family College Scholarship in its entirety
- Provide two letters of recommendation
- Complete an essay demonstrating financial need
- Provide a copy of their transcript; unofficial is acceptable
- No age restriction

Scoring of Applications

The Santa Ana Lodge Scholarship Committee will assess applications and select the winners. Winners will receive a "Verification of Enrollment" form to be completed after enrolling at the school you will be attending. When the Lodge receives that form and the required documentation of enrollment, a check will be sent as described on the verification form. If you elect to delay using the scholarship in the academic year for which it was awarded, a written request must be made to the Scholarship Chair. The scholarship must be used within 18 months of its receipt.

Provide/attach 2 **letters of recommendation** from **two** of the following: (1) a teacher, (2) a counselor, (3) a community member.

OPTIONAL: Test Scores & Awards

Although test scores are no longer required to complete this scholarship application, you have the option of attaching your **test score reports** (e.g., ACT, SAT) to this application for consideration. You may also attach any **awards or certificates** you have received for consideration.

 - e. Copies of any awards/certificates you wish to include (optional)
