### **History of the Brother Ed – General Education Scholarship**

This scholarship, established in 2020, has been made possible due to the generous donation from Brother Ed, a 2020 member of the Santa Ana Elks #794 Lodge. Scholarships will be awarded based on the qualifications of applicants.

### **Scholarship Award**

**For the 2021-2022 academic year, a minimum \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student who is planning to attend a 4-year college/university or graduate school.**

## Qualification of Applicants

To qualify for the Brother Ed – General Education Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following:

1. **Be one of the following:**
  - a. A high school senior in Santa Ana, Irvine, or Tustin OR
  - b. A community college student who plans to transfer to a 4-year college/university OR
  - c. A 4-year college/university student OR
  - d. A current member of the Santa Ana Elks #794 in good standing for at least one year & plan to attend a 4-year college/university OR
  - e. A child, stepchild, grandchild, step-grandchild of a current member of the Santa Ana Elks Lodge #794, who has been a member in good standing for at least one year, and the applicant plans to attend a 4-year college/university.
2. **Believe in God.**
3. Be an **American citizen.**
4. Complete a Brother Ed General Education **Scholarship Application** in its entirety.
5. Provide/attach **2 letters of recommendation** from: (a) a current teacher or counselor, (b) a community member or an employer.
6. Have been the recipient of **no more than one previous** Brother Ed Scholarship.

## Scoring of Applications

The Santa Ana Elks #794 Scholarship Committee will assess applications and select the winners. Winners will receive a “**Verification of Student Enrollment**” form to be completed **after** they have enrolled at the school they will be attending. After the Scholarship Committee receives the Verification of Student Enrollment form and the required documentation of enrollment in the Fall, a check will be mailed to the address on record. If we do not receive the verification form and documentation by Dec. 31, the award will be forfeited.
